

Satisfactory Progress in the “Three-Plus-Three Program”

Roger Williams University undergraduate students admitted into the Three-Plus-Three Program will demonstrate superior academic performance in order to remain in good standing in the program. That performance must meet the following criteria:

1. Achieve a minimum grade of B- in the following courses:
 - a. ECON 101
 - b. ECON 102
 - c. WTNG 102
 - d. WTNG 220
 - e. CORE 102
 - f. CORE 104
2. At the end of the sophomore year, students must have earned a minimum of 56 credits with at least a 3.5 cumulative grade point average and must present no serious character and fitness issues
3. At the end of the junior year, students must have earned a minimum of 90 credits, with at least a 3.5 cumulative grade point average, must have satisfied all requirements of the Modified Undergraduate Course of Study for the Program, must have taken the LSAT during their junior year, and must present no serious character and fitness issues.

Failure to maintain these criteria will result in the inability to apply for, or result in the automatic removal from the program.
